In light of these changes, I want to answer some questions you might have regarding COVID's effect on the Center.

**In what ways has COVID-19 impacted the Center?** Our doors remain open; however we have implemented precautions in order to reduce the spread of the virus and have temporarily suspended our parenting program until further notice.

We are serving clients seeking a pregnancy test and parenting options counsel and have instituted a screening process prior to scheduling an appointment.

We continue to accept donations and distribute emergency resources as needed.

**Have we been mandated by the state to close our doors?** No. Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-33-20 and state public health guidelines, we fall within the exemptions of social and health services as an essential entity of "workers who provide support to vulnerable populations to ensure their health and well-being..."

**Why do we remain open?** In times of societal crisis where financial and health uncertainties exist, our services of offering help and hope to women facing tough decisions are more important than ever.

**Are we postponing the upcoming Banquet on April 23?** Yes. Because we do not know how long the sheltering-at-home mandate will continue, we are in the process of rescheduling the Banquet to the fall, Lord willing!

**One truth the coronavirus has taught us:** Life is valued and worth protecting around the world. Let's pray that this same resolve includes life and protection for the unborn.
